


introverted girlfriends

Membership Policy





Thank you for joining our Meetup group! Our vision is to create a safe space for introverted women to promote and uplift each other. The purpose of the Meetup group is for introverted girlfriends to get out of the house, develop a social network and build lasting friendships with genuine women.

About Us

Janaya Sadler created Introverted Girlfriends, the Meetup group after moving to Charlotte, NC with no friends. Being the "new girl" in a new city, she felt lost in the crowd when she went out. It was the first time she recognized the need for an outlet for introverted females. She decided to create Introverted Girlfriends to give these women a safe space to get together in small groups to network and build friendships.

She later moved to Raleigh, NC and Sophia White, the Co-Organizer took over the Charlotte Meetup group. She opened an Introverted Girlfriends group in Raleigh, NC and Greensboro, NC.

The groups took off, and there was a demand for similar groups in other cities. Janaya and Sophia decided to partner to expand the vision globally.

Our Roles

Janaya and Sophia as Organizer and Co-Organizer are in charge of overseeing the vision and mission of Introverted Girlfriends. Each city also has Event Organizers who are responsible for organizing and coordinating events in their city.

Membership Policy

This group is for introverted women.

The group is private. Only members can see content of the group.

Please be nice! No mean girls allowed.

Profile Picture

You must have a picture of yourself uploaded to your profile for safety and transparency. Please do not use a picture of your dog, your favorite scene or celebrity as your profile picture.

RSVPing and Attending an Event

Meetups are small and intimate NOT to exceed 12 guests unless noted. Introverts prefer to spend time in small groups. That is the premise of the group.

If an event is full and you want to attend, join the waitlist. It's highly likely that you will still be able to attend, if you are one of the first few people on the waitlist.

If you RSVP YES and can't attend an event, please change your RSVP to NO as soon as you know that you will be unable to attend.

No Shows

A NO SHOW is defined as someone who RSVPs for an event and does not show up, and also does not change their RSVP to NO.

Two NO-SHOW ups in a six month period will result in you being removed from the group.

If you "attend an event" but do not check in with the Event Organizer, you are also considered a NO SHOW.

You will not be allowed to rejoin the group for a 3-month period.

(Just change your RSVP. It is that simple.)

Late Changers

A LATE CHANGER is defined as a person who changes their RSVP within 24 hrs of an event.

Three LATE CHANGES in a six-month period will result in removal from the group.

You will not be allowed to rejoin the group for another 3 months.

We understand things happen at the last minute. In the event that you can't attend an event, please let the organizer know.

Rationale for NO SHOWS and LATE CHANGERS policy:

Picture this - You are so excited to RSVP for a Meetup event, because you have been waiting for forever to check out that new restaurant. You are new to the city and don't have friends, and don't want to go there by yourself. Unfortunately, you are waitlisted. No worries, maybe someone will cancel, and you will still be able to go. You check the Meetup site the day before, and see you are still on the waitlist. You go ahead and change your RSVP to NO and make other plans. You later find out that you would have still been able to go because there were 3 NO SHOWS, and 2 people that changed at the last minute. Yikes!

Reason 1 - It is inconsiderate of the other members in the group, and the Event Organizer.

Reason 2 - You block someone from coming.

Reason 3 - Changing reservations and altering numbers at the last minute reflects negatively on the group, not just you.

Dues

The cost to join the Meetup group is only \$5 a year. You will enter a trial for 30 days which will allow you to check out the group for free. Pay your dues before the trial is up to become a member. If after the 30 days you have not paid, Meetup will automatically remove you from the group. You may rejoin after payment.
